Palazzo San Pietro is an exceptional and unique Venetian dream come true!

Depicted by Canaletto and Guardi, Casa Codussi stands beside a 16th century church designed by Palladio and a 15th century bell tower by Codussi. With stunning views in every direction and private water front and deck, Casa Codussi is a very special discovery. The church of San Pietro in Castello was, for 365 years, up until 1807, the patriarchal church of Venice and seat of the religious authority in the adjacent Palazzo del Patriarca. It is located between the two major exhibition centers

in Venice, Giardini della Biennale and Arsenale. This is the perfect destination for those who wish to discover the 'real Venice' and escape the crowds of tourists. From San Pietro guests have the privileged opportunity to be taken to the secret hidden gems inside Venice as well as beyond to the islands and the nearby hinterland. At San Pietro you can eat or have drinks on the private deck over the water, on the first floor terrace, in the atmospheric loft or on the altana (wooden terrace above the roof) overlooking Venice. Inside, Casa Codussi can only be described as 'amazing'! Successful and well known interior designer, Ilaria Miani, has created another gem. Not only has San Pietro been cleverly and thoughtfully restored in keeping with its tradition but it has also been furnished and decorated with absolutely exquisite style. Nothing has been left wanting. Spacious bedrooms with fabulous modern en suite bathrooms, kitchens on two levels with the principal one

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on the ground floor equipped for catering for anything from cookery classes to large events and to die for 'altanas' (decks & terraces) where one can relax with a chilled prosecco and watch the movement of boats on the canals.

The ground floor enjoys a 1,000 sq feet vaulted room, the Cavana, ideal for indoor dining, parties, conferences, meetings, dancing, cinema; and a spa area with gym and large hot tub looking out onto the garden. From here one passes through two double glass doors to the quite unique and splendid garden area with pergola, a garden lounge with kitchen counter and a 800 sq ft shed area, the Squero, ideal for gatherings or al fresco dining. This recent addition to Casa Codussi is exceptional from a design perspective and a really unique creation. With comfy armchairs and



a totally relaxing environment, here guests can enjoy drinks or meals by the large jetty and the previous boat shelter, the Squero, has now been redesigned to provide space for parties and celebrations in an al fresco environment. 
