Transport:

Fly in to Catania airport "Fontanarossa":

- Car Transfer & Hydrofoil/Yacht
- Private Transfer to Milazzo port by car up to 3 people €140 one way / from 4 to 8 people
- € 180 one way, from Milazzo direct hydrofoil to Salina Santa Marina (1h30' drive and 1h30' by hydrofoil)
- Boat Transfer with Motor Yacht, from Milazzo port to Salina Island including aperitif on board

Helicopter Transfer

- Private helicopter transfer from Catania airport to Salina Island from € 1.950 + Taxes
- One way, up to 5 or 6 people. (20' flight)

From Naples port:

- Hydrofoil - From the end of May until the beginning of September a direct hydrofoil departs every day at 14:00 and reaches Salina Santa Marina at 20:00
