

They then set about restoring a bunch of crumbling buildings into this very special 'boutique' guest house called Casa Talia.

Each of the bedrooms is individually designed and decorated with exceptional taste and style maintaining the traditional Sicilian feel at the same time as using more contemporary features. All of the rooms are light and spacious with their own little terrace where guests can enjoy relaxing under the shade with a chilled glass of Sicilian wine after exploring the winding streets of Modica. A delicious breakfast including freshly made Sicilian pasticceria (pastries), and freshly squeezed Sicilian orange juice is served on the terrace or in the cool and spacious living/dining room.

Modica is situated in the heart of the Val di Noto in Southern Sicily and is noted for its rich Baroque architecture typical of this area where an earthquake destroyed much of these cities in 1693. The site where the town is, has been inhabited since prehistoric times, was then conquered by the Arabs and the Aragonese and then was enriched with churches and baroque buildings after the earthquake.

Since 2003 Modica has been under the heritage of UNESCO and Casa Talia is situated in the old Jewish quarter, a short distance from the main street of the town.

Furthermore Modica is famous throughout the world for its chocolate which has a tradition dating back to the 1800s and is now recognized as producing one of the world's best quality of chocolate, high in cocoa and using natural ingredients. As well as chocolate, the region is renowned for its Nero d'Avola wine, pachino tomatoes and pecorino cheese of Ragusa thus providing lovers of food and wine with plenty of exciting discoveries.


