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Surrounded by the majestic cliffs of the Conturines, the village of San Cassiano nestles in lush mountain meadows at the centre of the Alta Badia district. The dramatic Dolomite peaks glint pinky-orange in the sunlight, offering just a hint of the 1,200kms of piste and the world-ranking climbing and walking routes that lie within the 'Dolomiti Superski'. This is an extremely sought-after destination, in both the summer and winter seasons, amongst the mountain cogniscenti and the family owned Rosa Alpina offers the highest standards of accommodation; just the right balance of luxurious pampering and warm Ladin hospitality.

San Cassiano has only a minimal amount of traffic through it so one may wander freely through the shops full of local products - smoked speck hams and strudels – many have facades painted with bright frescoes. One can enjoy the delicious regional specialities and more international cuisine in the exclusive Michelin starred St Hubertus (one of four restaurants to choose from) and ease the exertions of a day in the mountains at the Daniela Steiner Spa – the utmost luxury in an elegant environment filled with down-filled leather lounge sofas and soft music.

Each of the bedrooms is luxurious yet unique and all are furnished elegantly in a low-key style with antiques, paintings and materials that reflect the Ladin culture - wood, linen and marble. The overall atmosphere is one of a small, family-run hotel - warm and welcoming - that manages to convey the feeling of being 'at home' whilst offering the absolute utmost in hotel facilities and accommodation. The friendly and relaxed atmosphere, the unmatched scenery of the Dolomites, fantastic skiing and walking and the luxurious rooms and spa facilities combine



to provide one with what has to be one of the most special hotels worldwide. One cannot fail to be mesmerised by the Rosa Alpina be it in winter or summer and the attention to detail on every level is quite exceptional.

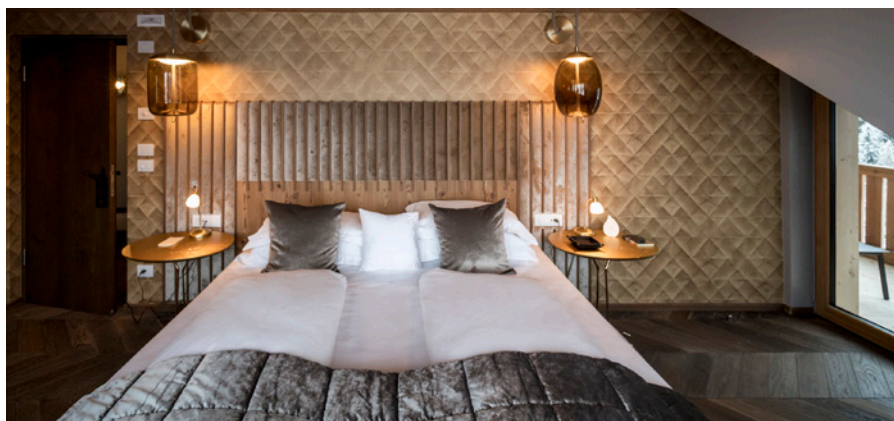

- Capacity: 36 plus a smoking room
- A warm inviting atmosphere for drinks or afternoon tea with live piano performances in the evening

The Spa

- Surrounded by forest views, the spa features an adults only indoor swimming pool, cold plunge pool, Finnish Sauna, steam bath and nine luxurious treatment rooms
- Signature treatments include the Alpine Herbal Muscle Relief, designed to restore guests after long days outdoors

The Yoga Studio

- Located on the first floor with large bright windows overlooking the forest
- Pilates and Hatha or Raja Yoga classes are available upon request
- During the Summer months, guests can book outdoor yoga experiences

Gym

- State-of-the-art gym fitted with the latest equipment and with sweeping woodland views

Family Wellness

- A separate wellness area features a Jacuzzi, indoor swimming pool and workout area
- The family friendly indoor swimming pool is 13m in length, with magnificent views out to the private garden and the forest
- Open from 7am-8pm and welcoming children of all ages

Other Facilities

- Cinema Capacity: 12
- Open upon request for pizza and movie nights
- Library & Billiard Room - This wood-panelled, sunlit space filled with books and comfortable sofas around a central fireplace overlooks the forest through floor-to-ceiling glass windows and features its own terrace
- Private Garden - ideal for relaxing in the Summer months, the garden also features a climbing wall. The intimate garden can also be used for small events

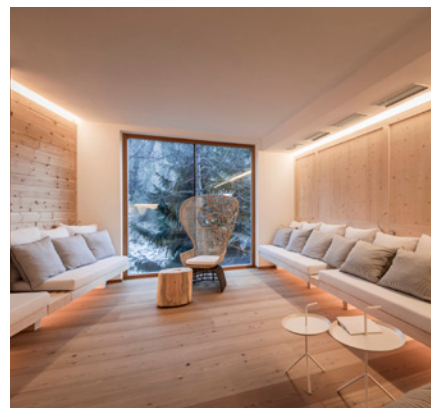
The Pizzinini Mountain Cabins

- Two private mountain cabins at 2,000m
- Available for private lunches catered for by the hotel
- Cabin Trugnei, is also available for overnight excursions with a private dinner experience



Winter Activities

- Skiing
- San Cassiano is connected to the Dolomiti Superski area with 1200 km of slopes and 450 lifts all covered under one ski pass
- The beautifully groomed runs have snow making facilities so there's always snow to ski. The area offers picture-perfect runs for all levels
- There are many perfect areas for mountaineering
- Cross-country skiing
- Winter hiking tours, snow shoeing, mountaineering, ice climbing, tobogganing, sky running and ice skating on either a nearby natural lake or ice rink

- A Unesco Natural Heritage site, surrounded by many natural parks offering a range of trails from easy excursions to more demanding treks
- Many hikes start directly from the hotel with no need for car transfers

- Mountain biking tracks offer both forest and meadow routes for cyclists of all levels. Mountain bikes are available to hire from the hotel
- Popular for dramatic road biking routes through the mountains including the popular annual
