Immersed amidst the the beautiful umbrella pine forest of Roccamare, Villa La Favorita is very special indeed. Steeped in history, Villa La Favorita was built in 1963 by the famous Italian architect Ugo Miglietta for Wanda Ferragamo, Salvatore Ferragamo's wife, and belongs today to her grandson Salvatore. Located in a quite idyllic location close to the beach Villa La Favorita is the perfect combination of great taste and comfort mixed with those special personal touches that create a true home.

Set within 10 acres of perfectly curated garden where umbrella pines abound, Villa La Favorita could not be a better destination for beach lovers! Walk through the little wooden gate of the garden and only a few steps later (90 metres) one is on the sandy beach of Roccamare! Here, guests will love the opportunity of an early morning swim in the clear and clean water as well as early evening as the sun sets on the horizon with views to Giglio and Elba and sometimes even Corsica! The Pineta di Roccamare is a private gated community with controlled

access and the beach, whilst not officially private, is extremely civilised and tranquil. There are even two private beach cabanas (one with lounge chairs and one with changing area where one can also leave beach games), in what seems almost quite the Robinson Crusoe beach!

On arrival one cannot fail to be struck by the understated beauty of the property with geraniums adorning the stone walls of the entrance. Inside one enters the light and spacious living areas with tastefully furnished dining and sitting room

with open fireplace, soft comfy sofas, books, wonderful pieces of art and delightful artefacts collected by this most illustrious family. There is also a study for those perhaps needing to keep up with work whilst away, as well as a cosy TV room for teenagers – but, arguably, who would wish to pull themselves away from the beach and the garden?!The dining room with its large French windows looks on to the terrace and garden of the beach side of the villa that enjoys two living corners of opposing couches and a large table for al fresco dining.

The newly designed kitchen is to die for and quite the dream for those guests who love to relax on holiday creating culinary delights. Extremely well equipped and designed, this light and spacious environment has been extremely well designed and opens onto a delightful and more intimate outdoor dining area on the garden side of the house. Each of the bedrooms enjoys en suite facilities



and reflects the delightful sense of staying in a cherished home steeped in character where luxury abides and yet nothing is over the top. Different colour themes adorn each bedroom and bathroom providing character and warmth. All are spacious and beautifully appointed providing the ultimate in comfort and most opening onto the gorgeous garden.

The perfectly positioned pool is quite the place for lazy days beneath the









umbrella pines and relaxing with a book and glass of local Maremma vino. Guests will love walks along the beach and excursions to the many fabulous places nearby and further afield be it Castiglione just down the road, nearby Punta Ala with its famous golf course, local Etruscan archaeological sites, Tuscan thermal baths of Calidario and Saturnia or even a trip to Siena for the day.
